Legend & Method

HTS codes covered: 7102.10.00 (unsorted), 7102.31.00 (rough, non-industrial), 7102.39.00 (worked/polished, non-industrial). In every carve-out identified in the guidance, these three codes always travel together — so within this table, rough and polished always receive the identical rate for a given country.

■ Green cells (0%): the country either has a diamond-specific carve-out heading (e.g. EU → 9903.05.97) that removes 7102 codes from the Section 301 duty entirely, or the country is not among the 60 named economies at all.

■ Red cells (10% or 12.5%): no carve-out for 7102 codes was found for this country in the guidance or the HTS list attachment — the general country-level Section 301 rate applies in full.

■ Yellow cells ("See note"): Canada and Mexico's exemptions (9903.05.93 / 9903.05.94) are conditioned on the goods being entered free of duty under USMCA — this is a customs certification/origin question, not an automatic product-code carve-out like the others in this table. Confirm with a customs broker before treating these as 0%.

Base MFN (column 1) assumption: standard US tariff treatment for non-industrial rough and polished diamonds (7102.31/7102.39) is Free (0%) outside of this Section 301 action. This is long-standing US tariff treatment, not something stated explicitly in CSMS #69326983 — verify against the current HTSUS if using this table for a compliance filing.

"Diamond industry relevance" (Y / Minor / N) is a qualitative judgment by AWDC about whether a country is a materially significant origin, cutting/polishing, or trading hub for natural diamonds — it is not part of the CBP guidance itself.

Countries relevant to the industry but NOT among the 60 named economies (Botswana, Namibia, DRC, Zimbabwe, Lesotho, Sierra Leone, Ghana, Guinea, Côte d'Ivoire, Central African Republic, Tanzania) are listed at the bottom of the main table with 0% and a note that they carry no Section 301 exposure at all under this action.
